

Dear Student or Student Parent/Guardian,

I am an experienced instrumental music teacher specialising in electric, acoustic, and classical guitar, ukulele, and piano. I am going to be offering lessons at South Kirkby academy soon.

The lessons take place during school time and are centred around the student's interest. I work with students to discover their preferred styles and aspirations and take them in that direction; from learning some chords to play campfire songs to becoming a professional classical performer.

Students will eventually need their own instrument to play and practice on. I can fix certain small problems with instruments for the student as long as materials are provided eg. strings. Proper maintenance of the instrument is part of what the student will learn. I can recommend some good quality beginner instruments if needed, please contact me on the details above.

If you are interested in lessons for your child, please fill in this letter and return it as soon as possible. My rates are detailed below. **The first lesson for any new student is completely free of charge.** Also, if you are interested in lessons for yourself, I also teach adults and would encourage you to contact me with the details in the top right to arrange a time. The rates are the same as detailed below but may include a petrol fee if I am travelling exclusively to your home, but I try to avoid that by scheduling private lessons when I'm already going to be nearby.

SKA will subsidise the cost of lessons for children in receipt of pupil premium funding. If your child does not receive pupil premium funding but you require additional financial support, please contact the school office.

Fees are as follows:

30-Minute Individual Session - £15/wk

15-Minute Individual Session - £7.50/wk

30-Minute Paired Session - £8.40/wk - *This will only be available if an appropriate partner is available. Otherwise, a student can be on a waiting list for a partner while taking another lesson type.*

Invoices are currently sent out on the first of each month, with payment due on the 15th. Alternative arrangements can be made on request.
