Dear Parents / Carers,

As part of our Geography topic, the children in Year 5 are going to be learning all about Coasts next term. We will be looking at a range of areas such as coastal locations as well as physical features of a coastal town. To be able to enrich their learning, we have booked a trip to Filey beach on Tuesday 15th November. We will aim to leave school by the slightly earlier time of 8:30am but will aim to return by our usual school time of 3:20pm. On the day it will all be dependent on traffic but we will make sure we keep you updated if there are any changes.

The full cost for the day is £12.00 this includes transport, the day at the beach, an ice-cream treat. During our time there we will ensure the children get the opportunity to see the Geography we are studying brought to life. They will take part in lots of activities such as sketching of the coastal location, a 'can you spot' activity and we will have a look at the effects of tourism in order to help them identify some of the features and to explore the coastal location.
