#### **School attendance rewards:**

Please find a quick reminder of rewards in school for good attendance below:

Weekly Celebrations	<ul> <li>Each week, the class with the highest attendance is announced in assembly and they receive a certificate in praise assembly.</li> <li>They are also able to come to school the following Friday in non-uniform, as shared on our weekly newsletter (SKA Headlines).</li> <li>Children whose attendance is 95% or above for the week will get entered into the Attendance Raffle.</li> </ul>
Half-termly Celebrations	<ul> <li>Children whose attendance is 95% or above receive a certificate of recognition and receive a 'Lucky Dip' prize.</li> <li>The winning class with the best attendance receives a special treat at the end of each term.</li> <li>At the end of the half-term, there will be a raffle to win a £50 Amazon Gift Voucher for the child and their family. This is linked to the weekly Attendance Raffle – the more weeks your child is at school 95% of the time or more, the more chances they will have to win. For example, if their attendance is better than 95% for 7 weeks, they will get entered into the raffle 7 times.</li> <li>At the end of the half-term, the child with the most improved attendance will also receive a £50 Amazon Gift Voucher for them and their family.</li> </ul>
