Dear families,

Further to my communication with you all before the half-term holiday, I have unfortunately been reported to Wakefield Council for doing the crossing patrol myself on the afternoon of Friday 10th February and morning of Monday 20th February and therefore am unable to continue with this.

As you will understand, this is extremely frustrating after a child was knocked down before the half-term holiday.

I therefore strongly recommend that all families – when and where possible – walk their children to and from school to assist them with crossing the road.
