WHAT IS ABUSE?

If someone deliberately hits you, hurts you or injures you.

If someone shouts, threatens, hits, or hurts someone you love while you are around. This may make you scared, unhappy and worried.

If someone doesn't take proper care of you so you feel abandoned, lonely or neglected.

If someone makes you look at things which make you feel ashamed, embarrassed, uncomfortable or guilty.

If someone touches you in a way that you don't like, for example touching your private parts.
