The following information guides you through our learning in Year 6 for the next half term. Please do not hesitate to ask your child's class teacher any questions.

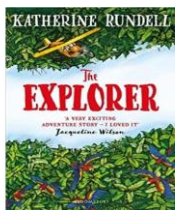


English



Following this in our writing we will start our exciting new class novel 'The Explorer' by Katherine Rundell. From this, our writing will be based around descriptions and story writing based on the events from the story. We will also be debating writing a balanced argument on the complex issue of deforestation.

Our reading will lead us into learning about the Amazon Rainforest, as this is the setting from our class story. We will also begin to look at other pieces of descriptive text.

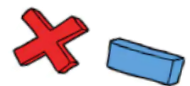
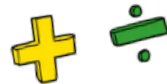


Maths

In Maths, we will be continuing our learning into long multiplication and solving problems using long multiplication. We will then focus on fractions.

In this learning, we will understand what a fraction is and how to write fractions, recapping from previous years (numerator/denominator) and how fractions can be pictorially represented. We will be learning how to multiply and divide fractions by whole numbers. We will also begin to link fractions, decimals and percentages.

Children should use Times Tables Rockstars to practise their multiplication tables.



Science

This half term we will be continue our learning about the adaptation and evolution of animals. In this topic of learning we will look at how different animals are classified and how they have adapted to their environments over time.

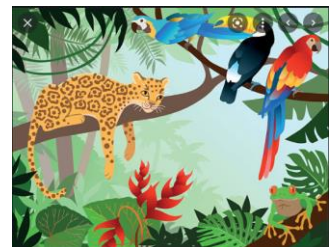
History & Geography
