We will start our Writing by 'going back to basics' and covering all things sentence structure to help with our future pieces of writing.

In Reading, children shall be developing their strategies for understanding what they have read our class novel is Dracula (Kids Classics).

We have carefully chosen this text to fit in with our visit to Whitby, and although it is a Kids Classic, we will be sensitive in the way in which we read the story and share its content.





Maths.

We will start our Maths with some work on place value. Children will be introduced to writing fractions as decimals, starting with tenths and then moving onto hundredths.

Once we have mastered this area of Maths, we will apply our learning to a variety of real-life contexts, including measuring and money.

Children will continue to practise the four operations to ensure that they can do it back to front, upside down and with their eyes closed. They will also complete daily arithmetic questions each lesson to maintain their mental maths skills.
