English



This half term we are going to be reading a text called Kensuke's Kingdom. Throughout the term both our reading and writing lessons will be based around this with the aim of writing a character description, a setting description and looking closely at the skills needed to ensure our writing is the best it can be.

Please remember children should be reading a variety of material at home (including MyOn at least 3 times per week. We will be introducing Boom Reader which is an online version of a reading record, this should help to make sure you are able to record down when your child has read. We are big advocates for reading for pleasure so please encourage your child to read at home and even take trips to the library to widen their knowledge on the range of texts out there.



Maths

This term we will be learning developing and embedding our knowledge of place value and the methods needed to understand the 4 operations. We will continue to follow NCETM as well as ensure daily arithmetic and times table practice.

Children will do daily rapid recall to ensure they retain previous knowledge surrounding .

Children should use Times Tables Rockstars to practise their multiplication tables on a weekly basis at home.

Their log ins for TT Rockstars will be sent home so they have a record of this to use. We will also be sending home weekly homework to help with their arithmetic and reasoning practice.



Science

This half term we will be studying **Classification of Living Things**. We will understand and be able to describe how living things can be grouped based on similarities and give reasons for this.
