IMPORTANT REMINDER - COLLECTION FROM CLUBS & AFTER SCHOOL EVENTS

ALL children, regardless of age or year group, **must** be collected from their after-school clubs. This is because it is now dark when after-school clubs finish. Please plan for your child to be collected promptly when their club finishes. If this does not happen, children will not be able to attend. Please remember that all after-school clubs are run by staff who give up their free time and not collecting your children promptly extends this time – they are busy teachers who have lots to do. Thank you for your support with this.

ATTENDANCE - 96% IS OUR SCHOOL TARGET

On the run up to half-term, attendance in school was excellent – we had weeks of achieving 95%, 96% and 97%. Since half-term, this has dipped considerably. Most absence is illness or unauthorised – if it is unauthorised, it means we do not know why your child has been off and have not been given a reason. It may also be because your child has arrived at school after 9:10am – this is then recorded as an unauthorised absence.













I always share the message with the children that it is of course okay to be off poorly, however sometimes it is best to send your children in and see how they get on. We will of course contact you if we do not think they are well enough to stay at school.

I am sharing the following NHS link again <u>here</u>, which is really useful if you are not sure. You can also ring the school office to speak to Mrs Studd or Mrs Neary, who will give helpful advice of whether or not to send your child to school.

We have also put measures in place in school to keep everyone well, including increased ventilation and higher levels of hand cleaning with sanitising gel. Please help us support school attendance as we move through winter bug season!


