Parent Governor Vacancy

A more formalised role within school is that of a parent governor. Governors for schools exist to improve educational standards so that children have the chance to realise their full potential. Their role is a responsibility for overseeing the management side of a school: strategy, policy, budgeting and staffing. If you get on well with people, would like to learn new or develop existing skills, and are interested and committed to helping children and young people, this may be for you. We currently have one parent governor vacancy.

Becoming a school governor involves:

- Attending three meetings per year (one each term ours are 4:30pm-6:30pm and dates are set in the summer for the whole of the next year)
- Attending school events on a voluntary basis.
- Attending school with focus areas on a voluntary basis.
- Maintaining professional boundaries as you will be subject to sensitive and confidential information.
- Completing statutory safeguarding training and other governor induction training.
