

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5 GOVERNMENT CHANGES TO ATTENDANCE

Legally enforced from August 2024

"I'm a single parent/carer of 1 child and want to go on holiday for a week during term time."

You must fill out a leave of absence request form with accompanying letter to notify school of the holiday. The holiday will not be authorised unless there are exceptional circumstances. You will be given a penalty notice if your child misses 5 school days (10 sessions). The fine is £160, reduced to £80 if paid within 21 days.

A penalty is given for each child.

1 parent with 4 children = £640 reduced to £320 if paid within 21 days.

£160

£640

For a family of two parents. £1280, reduced to £640 if paid

Both parents/carers are fined for each child. For example:

2 parents with 4 children = within 21 days

£320 £320 £320 £320

Multiple holidays or patterns of irregular attendance within 3 years. (2 parents)

2nd offence 1 child: £320

NO

3rd offence No penalty notice. Instead, your case will be taken to court. A magistrate can fine each parent £2500 for each child

DISCOUNT 2 children: £640 **FOR EARLY** 3 children: 960 PAYMENT 4 children: £1280

1 parent & 4 children: £10,000 2 parents & 4 children: £20,000

Irregular Attendance '10 in 10' 1 DAY = 2 SESSIONS

If your child has 10 sessions of unauthorised absence within a rolling period of 10 school weeks or less, we will consider prosecution. These sessions may be consecutive or not.

Example: 3 days of unauthorised absence in one week + one day of absence per week for the next two weeks = 10 sessions (irregular attendance)
